Temple Square Christmas Lights in Salt Lake City, UT

The Temple Square Christmas Lights are on every night through January 2 in Salt Lake City and they are well worth seeing! There is a life-sized Nativity scene near the North Visitors Center. Christmas music is always playing in the background and live bands put on performances as well.

Gardner Village in West Jordan, UT

Christmastime at Gardner Village is a recreation of Santa’s North Pole workshop located in West Jordan, Utah. There is a Scavenger Hunt through the village for children 12 and under to find all of the elf displays, with candy prizes for children who find all of the displays. The old-style village also features 22 locally owned shops decorated for the Christmas season. West Jordan is located about 12 miles south of Salt Lake City.
